Frequently Asked Questions

How far do you book out?

It depends on the season, however since we are a boutique company specializing in intimate bridal parties, 4-6 months before is usually sufficient.

Do you offer touchup services?

Yes, we do, however unless your wedding is in the hot summer months, they are not necessarily needed. Most of our brides photographed in our social media have not had touchups. We can go over your look during your trial and let you know if touch ups would be in your best interest, along with the time of year of your wedding.

How should your hair be prepared beforehand?

This is in all our clients' contracts, however it is best to have the hair one-day dirty, so it should be professionally washed and blown out the day before with little-to-no product, unless otherwise told to you by our stylist.

Should you have inspiration photos for hair and makeup?

Yes! For our consultations to be maximized in a short amount of time, photos let us understand what is going on in your mind and let us get the most out of our quick convos before we start.

Best Practices for Day-Of Event

- Please make sure anything that needs to be steamed is done PRIOR to anyone getting their hair done, preferable in the days before. Steam creates frizz and our timelines do not allow us to fix hairstyles post steaming.
- Avoid getting ready in shirts that need to be taken off over your head, or that have fuzzy or fleece collars, this creates frizz, and over the head just doesn't work if you are getting your hair or makeup done. Zip-ups, button-downs and cotton or satin robes are best.
- Being on time is MOST crucial. All contracts are based on a time schedule, and anyone running late can create a blip in that schedule. Please be mindful of the time, for us and for you.
